



# (Leh – Turtuk -UmlingLA - Leh) 8 Days

## **Departure Dates for 2024**

May- 7,21 June- 4,18 July- 2,16,30 Aug -12,24 Sep-10,24, Oct- 8

## Day 1: Leh -Arriving Day

Welcome at KUSHOK BAKULA RINPOCHE AIRPORT LEH rest the whole day and let your body acclimatize atHotel. Overnight Stay at The Leh Hotel.

## Day 2: Leh - Khardung La - Nubra Valley - 120 KM

Start the journey to Khardung -La passes 18380 Ft. The highest motor-able road in The World. Further, continuethe journey toward Nubra Valley. Enjoy the scenic beauty and reach Camp Site by evening

# Day 3: Nubra Valley – Turtuk – 160 KM

The village offers views of Beautiful Valley, part of the Shyok Valley. Turtuk was part of the Silk Route. Turtuk isone of the few places in India where one can witness Balti culture, and one can find a few homestays and guesthouses in the village. It is the last major village where tourist activity is allowed before the LOC. Enjoy the scenicbeauty and reach Camp Site by evening.

## Day 4: Nubra Valley – Pangong TSO – 170 KM

We'll see dunes in no-man land, enjoy camel ride & photoshoot. The route is less travelled, but the most adventures one. Be ready to test your riding skill. Reach Pangong Lake by afternoon. Spend the evening inCamps at lake. Enjoy dinner and overnight stay in camp.

#### Day 5: Pangong TSO -Hanle - 200 KM

The real beauty of Pangong Lake you will observe on this day. In chushul, we will visit Rezang La war memorial.

Hanle has a lovely Monastery offering some great aerial views of the whole village that is ahome of about 1000 people with altitude of 4500 Mtrs.

The Hanle Observatory is operated by the Indian Institute of Astrophysics, Bengaluru and currently the second highest optical observatory in the world, with an installed telescope of about 2.01 meters (6.5 feet) diameter. Overnight stay at Hanle

# Day 6: Hale to UmlingLa and back to Hanle 180 KM

Today you will ride on the highest motorable road in the world.

Umling La is a mountain pass in Ladakh, India on the ridgeline between Koyul Lungpa and the Indus River near Demchok. At an elevation of 5,640 metres, it forms the source for the Umlungstream that drains into the Indus and a tributary of the Kiungdul river that drains into Koyul Lungpa. Overnight stay at Hanle.

# Day 7: Hanle to Leh

After a delicious breakfast, head back to Leh.

Pass through the picturesque landscape around that gives this place extremely romantic and breathtaking vibes. Experience the unique adventure bathing experience aside from the IndusRiver in **Chumathang Hot Water Spring**. Take a stopover at traditional attractions and reach Leh. Visit Leh market to shop for some goods and enjoy Ladakhi cuisine.

Overnight stay at a hotel in Leh.

# **Day 8: Departure from Leh**

Today is the last day of this adventurous trip. You can leave back for your home today, but you won't be going alone. You will be taking lots of fun memories, which you will cherish for a long time

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q. Which is the best time for Leh Ladakh Bike Trip?
- A. The route from Srinagar to Leh is only open from June to September. So these months are best to make this bike trip.
- Q. Which bike you provide for the trip?
- A. We provide 350cc Royal Enfield Bikes.
- Q. Can we have any option in bikes?
- A. Yes, you have other options of Bajaj Avenger, Royal Enfield 500 and Himalayan.
- Q. Do you have any right shift gear bikes?
- A. No, we don't have bikes with right shift gears.
- Q. What things do you provide with the bike?
- A. We provide all the accessories like Carrier, helmets, Gloves, Cans for fuel etc. on nominal charges.
- Q. What about the condition bikes?
- A. We provide all bikes in perfect conditions, with adding new bikes to our fleet every year.
- Q. Is the fuel cost including on this trip?
- A. Yes, the fuel cost also included in this trip.
- Q. How is the condition of the road during the whole trip?
- A. 60% Roads are in good condition, in other 40% you can experience off-road driving.
- Q. Do I need to carry a full set of bike repair tools?
- A. No, you do not need to carry any kit regarding bike repair. We will provide you with a mechanic and every tool you do need during the trip.
- Q. Which transport you provide for the backup vehicle?
- A. In the backup vehicle, we mostly provide Mahindra Thar
- Q. What riding gear do I need for Ladakh trip?
- A. This is the kind of trip riding gear made for. Get a riding jacket, pants, shoes, gloves and a full-face helmet. Keep in mind that all of your riding gear should be good to go against rain, hail and snow.
- Q. Do I need to carry thermal wear?
- A. Yes, there will be very cold, so it is advisory to carry thermal wear.
- Q. What kind of food you provide during the trip?
- A. We provide food for 2 times in a day i.e. Breakfast & Dinner.
- Q. Do I need to carry any documents with me?
- A. Carry an original Driving Licence card and a passport size photograph.
- Q. Is there any lack of oxygen during the trip?
- A. Anybody travelling 10,000 feet above sea level will find difficulty in breathing or is likely to fall prey to altitude sickness. It happens due to low level of atmospheric oxygen. The biggest cause of AMS (Acute Mountain Sickness) is dehydration. People on the trip forget to drink enough water, they keep on riding. To beat AMS, take the following steps:
  - 1. Drink lots and lots of water mixed with glucose.
  - 2. Take everything slow. Even little labour at high altitudes will leave you spent.
  - 3. Take one Diamox at Srinagar on the morning when you leave for Leh. Diamox takes one hour to start working.
  - 4. Don't push too hard; take the trip slowly. Ascent slowly, decent.
- 5. If you feel the symptoms creeping up, stop and take some rest. Don't keep pushing.
- Q. Which language speaks in Ladakh?
- A. Ladakhi people speak local Ladakhi language though all of them understand Hindi with some of them (city dwellers) understand English too.
- Q. What about money exchange, can we use Debit/credit cards?
- A. Money can be exchanged only in Srinagar & Leh town; you can also use debit/credit card in a few of the reputed shops and hotels but at an additional 2% service tax.
- Q. Which network is accessible? A. During the whole trip you can get BSNL network at some places, in Srinagar you can getevery mobile network but in Ladakh region, you can only access postpaid BSNL, Airtel and Vodafone.
