Day 1 Delhi-Manali (By Volvo)

On the first day of your trip, board a Volvo bus to Manali from Delhi or Chandigarh. It will be an overnight journey, so make sure that you are well prepared.

Day 2 Explore Manali

Once you reach Manali, check-in at the hotel, rest for some time and get ready for an orientation process and tour briefing. Today's day is rest and acclimatization day. You may enjoy a relaxing nature walk to Hadimba Temple and Manu temple around Beas River on your own. Hadimba Temple is truly one-of-a-kind, as it is dedicated to Hadimba Devi, wife of the mighty Bhima from the Hindu epic Mahabharata. Manu Temple located near river Beas is dedicated to sage Manu, the creator of the World. When you return, you will get a chance to ride your allotted bike for a trial run in the evening. Breakfast, Dinner & Overnight Stay at hotel.

Day 3 Manali - Sarchu

Your long-awaited ride to Ladakh finally begins on this day. Pack your bags and get set for a thrilling ride. You will visit Solang Valley, known for a variety of winter sports, followed by Rohtang Pass and Keylong. We will cross Atal tunnel also so be ready for rough riding. We will cross Suraj Tal. gear up for an adventure as you cross the 16,043-ft-high Bara-lacha la Pass in the Zaskar Range. The rough patches of Darcha and Zingzingbar will give you an adrenaline boost. Further, we will start the journey toward Sarchu. Dinner and Overnight Stay in Swiss Camps at Sarchu

Day 4 Sarchu – Leh

Today we will cross Tanglang-La-Pass(17,480ft). Enjoy the most beautiful sights that will take your breath away, but a mix of right roads and bad await us on our way to Leh.

Day 5: Leh - Khardung La - Nubra Valley

Start journey to Khardung-La passes 18380 Ft. The highest motor-able road in the World.

Further, continue the journey toward Nubra Valley. Enjoy the scenic beauty and reach Campsite by evening.

Day 6: Nubra Valley - Turtuk - Nubra Valley - 160 KM

The village offers views of Beautiful Valley, part of the Shyok Valley. Turtuk was part of the Silk Route. Turtuk is one of the few places in India where one can witness Balti culture, and one can find a few homestays and guest houses in the village. It is the last major village where tourist activity is allowed before the LOC. Enjoy the scenic beauty and reach Camp Site by evening.

Day 7: Nubra Valley - Pangong TSO

We'll see dunes in no-man land, enjoy camel ride & photoshoot. The route is less travelled, but the most adventures one. Be ready to test your riding skill. Reach Pangong Lake by afternoon. Spend the evening in Camps at lake. Enjoy dinner and overnight stay in camp.

Day 8: Pangong TSO - Leh

Be ready with your cameras and phone to click pictures. The view in the morning will take your breath away. We will cross Chang La today another highest pass. Reach Leh by evening, stay overnight.

Day 9 Leh - Sarchu

Today we will cross Tanglang-La-Pass(17,480ft). Enjoy the most beautiful sights that will take your breath away, but a mix of right roads and bad await us on our way to Leh.

Day 10: Sarchu - Manali

We will cross Baralacha-la-pass (16,040 ft). And witness another beauty Suraj Tal further we will start the journey toward Manali We will cross Atal Tunnel also so be ready for rough riding. Reach Manali in the evening.

Day 11: Manali

Explore Manali you may enjoy a relaxing nature walk to Hadimba Temple and Manu temple around Beas River on your own. Hadimba Temple is truly one-of-a-kind, as it is dedicated to Hadimba Devi, wife of the mighty Bhima from the Hindu epic Mahabharata in the evening take Volvo overnight journey.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Which is the best time for Leh Ladakh Bike Trip?

A. The route from Srinagar to Leh is only open from June to September. So these months are best to make this bike trip.

Q. Which bike you provide for the trip?

A. We provide 350cc Royal Enfield Bikes.

Q. Can we have any option in bikes?

A. Yes, you have other options of Bajaj Avenger, Royal Enfield 500 and Himalayan.

Q. Do you have any right shift gear bikes?

A. No, we don't have bikes with right shift gears.

Q. What things do you provide with the bike?

A. We provide all the accessories like Carrier, helmets, Gloves, Cans for fuel etc. on nominal charges.

Q. What about the condition bikes?

A. We provide all bikes in perfect conditions, with adding new bikes to our fleet every year.

Q. Is the fuel cost including on this trip?

A. Yes, the fuel cost also included in this trip.

Q. How is the condition of the road during the whole trip?

A. 60% Roads are in good condition, in other 40% you can experience off-road driving.

Q. Do I need to carry a full set of bike repair tools?

A. No, you do not need to carry any kit regarding bike repair. We will provide you with a mechanic and every tool you do need during the trip.

Q. Which transport you provide for the backup vehicle?

A. In the backup vehicle, we mostly provide Mahindra Thar

Q. What riding gear do I need for Ladakh trip?

A. This is the kind of trip riding gear made for. Get a riding jacket, pants, shoes, gloves and a full-face helmet. Keep in mind that all of your riding gear should be good to go against rain, hail and snow.

Q. Do I need to carry thermal wear?

A. Yes, there will be very cold, so it is advisory to carry thermal wear.

Q. What kind of food you provide during the trip?

A. We provide food for 2 times in a day i.e. Breakfast & Dinner.

Q. Do I need to carry any documents with me?

A. Carry an original Driving Licence card and a passport size photograph.

Q. Is there any lack of oxygen during the trip?

A. Anybody travelling 10,000 feet above sea level will find difficulty in breathing or is likely to fall prey to altitude sickness. It happens due to low level of atmospheric oxygen. The biggest cause of AMS (Acute Mountain Sickness) is dehydration. People on the trip forget to drink enough water, they keep on riding. To beat AMS, take the following steps:

1. Drink lots and lots of water mixed with glucose.
2. Take everything slow. Even little labour at high altitudes will leave you spent.
3. Take one Diamox at Srinagar on the morning when you leave for Leh. Diamox takes one hour to start working.
4. Don't push too hard; take the trip slowly. Ascent slowly, decent.
5. If you feel the symptoms creeping up, stop and take some rest. Don't keep pushing.

Q. Which language speaks in Ladakh?

A. Ladakhi people speak local Ladakhi language though all of them understand Hindi with some of them (city dwellers) understand English too.

Q. What about money exchange, can we use Debit/credit cards?

A. Money can be exchanged only in Srinagar & Leh town; you can also use debit/credit card in a few of the reputed shops and hotels but at an additional 2% service tax.

Q. Which network is accessible? A. During the whole trip you can get BSNL network at some places, in Srinagar you can get every mobile network but in Ladakh region, you can only access postpaid BSNL, Airtel and Vodafone.
